

Financial and social aid plans for the recovery of the municipality FINANCIAL PROGRAM

1 An amount of up to 1,000 euros will be subsidized for those establishments that have been forced to close their activity as a result of the declaration of the State of Alarm and re-opens and remains open until at least the 15th October 2020 (Terms and conditions apply).


2 Prompt payment plan to suppliers, guaranteeing payment in an average period of 12 days.

3 We are working on a collaboration with the Almería chamber of commerce to carry out measures to offer local business advice, training and the launch of a virtual or online platform to aid local business through online marketing.

4 We have exempted local trade from this year's payment of the public area/street occupancy fee: tables, chairs, displays and other similar items.

5 We will grant regular weekly market stall holders a 100% discount on the quarterly fee normally charged for the 4th quarter of 2020 of the public /street area occupancy fee.

6 The occupation of public land/domain with merchandise, construction materials, rubble, vats, containers, fences, scaffolding and other similar facilities, will be exempted from payment, for the period from the declaration of the State of Alarm until end of the year 2020.

7 The municipal VADOS Garage reserve space tax for the year 2020 will not be charged to hotel and restaurant establishments.

8 During the State of Alarm municipal use fees will not be generated and the proportional part of the quota already paid for the use of the municipal facilities and that have not been used will be returned.

9 Deferral of local all taxes.

10 No overdue local tax procedure will be initiated during the health crisis.


11 We will urge the local refuse (rubbish collection) consortium of eastern Almería to not charge the receipt corresponding to the second quarter of 2020 for the rubbish collection fee to those establishments forced to close as a result of the State of Alarm and to speed up the process for reducing the receipt as closed premises at the end of the tourist season.



Financial and social aid plans for the recovery of the municipality SOCIAL WELFARE PROGRAM

- 1 Financial contribution to the food bank of the local Spanish Red Cross.
- 2 Collaboration agreement between the Mojácar Council and the local Spanish Red Cross committee, to cover the food and hygiene needs of families in extreme vulnerability, to be taken from the local municipal budget.
- 3 Financial aid to cover the expenses of essential household supplies, through the emergency aid system of the municipal Social Services.
- 4 Increase in the budgeted amount for social aid.
- 5 Scholarships for school books and supplies for students ages 0 to 16 years old, for the academic year 2020-2021.
- 6 Reduction of the payment of fee for Municipal Sports and Music Schools for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- 7 Agreements between the Mojácar Council and large food stores in Mojácar, for the donation of basic necessities.
- 8 All those new born babies born in the Mojácar, between the 14th of March and 31st December 2020, and whose parents are unemployed, will be given a basket of basic baby products.
- 9 The Mojácar Council has made available a telephone hotline for social services related issues. Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. 677 959 093.

TOURISM AND LOCAL BEACHES

IMPLEMENTATION OF NECESSARY MEASURES AND MODIFICATIONS TO PROMOTE MOJÁCAR AS A "SAFE DESTINATION"

- 1 Increase the tourism promotion budget.
- 2 Reinforcing of health and safety measures on our beaches:
 - * Extra cleaning and disinfection of toilet modules, first aid and showers.
 - * Fitting of hydro-alcoholic gel dispensers in toilet modules.
 - * Additional Local Police to ensure compliance of the social distancing and capacity on the beach.
 - * Information signage.
- 3 Additional health and safety measures on public transport:
 - * Supply of face masks and hydro-alcoholic gel dispensers on local bus lines.
 - * Additional cleaning and disinfection of public transport and bus stops.
- 4 Additional cleaning and disinfection of streets, public areas and areas prone to more public affluence.
