PUBLIC INFORMATION**

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

The Town Hall of Mojacar would like to inform all foreign residents that are registered on the “Padron”, of the obligation to confirm their residence in this Town to continue registered on the Municipal “Padron”.

The current legislation dictates the cases where it is required to CONFIRM RESIDENCE, to continue registered, and they are the following:

European Union Residents that hold a Certificate of EU Resident with N.I.E. number, (this is the Green Resident Certificate you would have obtained from the Foreigners office), HAVE THE OBLIGATION TO RENEW THE PADRON REGISTRATION EVERY FIVE YEARS.

European Union members that are not registered as EU Resident (and therefore DO NOT hold a Green Certificate of EU Resident and only have an N.I.E. number, or those persons that do not have an N.I.E. number), HAVE THE OBLIGATION TO RENEW THE PADRON REGISTRATION EVERY TWO YEARS.

Non EU Residents that hold a long term (five years) or permanent Residency Permit, HAVE THE OBLIGATION TO RENEW THE PADRON REGISTRATION EVERY FIVE YEARS.

Non EU Residents that DO NOT hold a long term or permanent Residency Permit, HAVE THE OBLIGATION TO RENEW THE PADRON REGISTRATION EVERY TWO YEARS.

It is very important for all foreigners to confirm the Padron registration, if you do not renew the Mojacar Town Hall has the obligation to remove those foreigners from the Padron register, due to “incorrect registration” or “expiry of registration”.

You can check your registration or renew your registration with the Mojacar Town Hall within the public opening hours: Monday to Friday 9am to 2pm.

We will have additional personnel to assist you with this from the 27th of November to the 10th of December.
